

ORDINANCE NO. 06-O-65

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL
MECHANICAL CODE, 2006 EDITION, SUBJECT TO SPECIFIED AMENDMENTS**

An ordinance of the Village of Round Lake adopting the 2006 edition of the *International Mechanical Code* regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of mechanical systems in the Village of Round Lake; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; repealing Chapter 15.24 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Round Lake and all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict therewith.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROUND LAKE, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Municipal Code of the Village of Round Lake be amended by striking and deleting Chapter 15.24 of the Municipal Code and substituting in its place the following new Chapter 15.24 adopting the International Mechanical Code, 2006 Edition subject to specified amendments, all as follows:

Chapter 15.24

Mechanical Code Adopted

Sections:

15.24.010 International Mechanical Code, 2006 Edition, adopted.

15.24.020 Amendments and Revisions.

15.24.010 International Mechanical Code, 2006 Edition, adopted.

That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Clerk of Round Lake, being marked and designated as the *International Mechanical Code*, 2006 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Mechanical Code of the Village of Round Lake, in the State of Illinois regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of mechanical systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Mechanical Code on file in the office of the Village of Round Lake are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 15.28.050 of this chapter.

15.28.020 Amendments and Revisions.

The following sections of the International Mechanical Code, 2006 Edition, are amended and revised as hereinafter stated:

Section 101.1 Insert: Village of Round Lake

Section 106.5.2 Insert: Fees to be determined as indicated in the fee schedule shown in Chapter 15.08 of the Village of Round Lake Municipal Code

Section 106.5.3 Insert: 80% for both.

Section 108.4 Insert: Persons who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter or repair mechanical work in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the code official, or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of this code, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than 75.00 dollars or more than 750.00 dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding 180 days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues after due notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 108.5 Insert: "\$50.00" to specify the first amount and "\$750" to specify the second amount

Chapter 15 Delete all references to International Plumbing Code and replace with Illinois Plumbing Code.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: That nothing in this ordinance or in the Mechanical Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after ten (10) days of its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
